Switzerland

Swiss higher education institutions can apply for Swiss grants to finance incoming student mobility via the [Swiss – European Mobility Programme](#). For studies an inter-institutional agreement between the Swiss receiving institution and Leiden University is required. Traineeships in Switzerland are only possible if the traineeship is coordinated by a Swiss higher education institution. If you want to apply for a grant through the Swiss – European Mobility Programme, then you need to contact your receiving institution to discuss the possibilities.

Microstates

Andorra, Monaco, San Marino and Vatican City State are partner countries within the Erasmus+ programme. Grants for studies and traineeships in these countries are currently not coordinated by Leiden University.
