

Mandela Scholarship Fund Terms and Conditions

- 1. The student must be enrolled at one of the following universities: Stellenbosch University, University of Cape Town, University of Pretoria, or University of the Western Cape.
- 2. The student comes to Leiden University for an exchange for one or two semesters.
- 3. The student must be pre-selected and nominated for a scholarship by their home university.
- 4. The student must meet the admission requirements for exchange/study abroad students at Leiden University.
- 5. The Mandela Scholarship Fund cannot be combined with an Erasmus+ ICM Scholarship.
- 6. The Mandela Scholarship Fund comprises of a monthly allowance and an Aon Student Insurance for the duration of the exchange (5 or 10 months).
- 7. The student must comply with Dutch visa and residence permit regulations and the admission/application procedures of Leiden University.
- 8. The Mandela Scholarship Fund is granted for the academic year and semester as specified in the decision letter and cannot be transferred to another academic year or another semester within the same academic year. If the student changes the dates of their study programme, the scholarship will be revoked.
- 9. The Mandela Scholarship Fund will be paid in in monthly installments into a SEPA bank account upon completion of all Leiden University student registration formalities.
- 10. The student must accept the scholarship in the uSis scholarship portal by the deadline stated in the communication sent to them via uSis. If the awardee does not accept the scholarship before the deadline stated, the Mandela Scholarship Fund will be withdrawn.
