Why consider alternatives to exchange?



- Not eligible during your studies
- Don't want to stay away too long
- Other destinations in mind than exchange offers
- Courses abroad are not your priority
- Other personal reasons

Why go abroad

- Personal development (independence, flexibility, adaptability)
- Experience different learning practices
- Improve language skills
- Work together with people from different cultures
- Expand your academic network
- Enhance your future employability
- Experience studying abroad!

While studying at Leiden University

- Going abroad independently --> freemover
- Research or internship
- Summer/winter schools
- Minors abroad

After finishing your degree at Leiden University

• Entire Master's Degree abroad



Research or internship abroad

Some study programmes allow students to do an internship and/or research project for credits

Combine this with going abroad

Erasmus+ funding for training (= internship) For example:

- Internship at an Embassy, NGOs, Multinationals
- Fieldwork under supervision of researcher of host university
- Research work as part of your thesis

If you receive credits, you may be eligible for an Erasmus+ *or* Lustra Scholarship



Check with your faculty or study programme for options.

Summer and winter schools

- Short programme (2-4 weeks)
- Great introduction to study abroad
- Mostly fee paying, sometimes scholarships available.
- Some credit-bearing.
 - If approved by your BoE, you may be eligible for an Erasmus+ or Lustra+ Scholarship.
