

Terms and conditions Uhlenbeck conference scholarship

A. Part I

1. You are majoring in one of the following **research** master degree programmes at the Faculty of Humanities: African Studies, Arts and Culture, Asian Studies, Classics and Ancient Civilisations, History, Latin American Studies, Linguistics, Literary Studies, and Middle Eastern Studies;
2. You will actively participate in a conference;
3. You have not received a grant from the Uhlenbeck scholarship programme for the purpose of conference participation during your current degree programme;
4. You have registered the details of your travel and study abroad in Usis;
5. The country or region of your internship has not been assigned one of the following classifications by the Dutch Ministry of Foreign Affairs: *'We advise essential travel only'* or *'We advise against all travel'*. More information here:

7. Your application was submitted on time and is complete;
8. Based on your budget and plans the Humanities International Office will decide the amount of the grant;
9. The grant will be paid once it is established that you have met all requirements.
10. You have registered your study abroad period in the mobility management database of Usis;

B. Part II

1. Inform the Humanities International Office (studyabroad@hum.leidenuniv.nl) as soon as possible when your conference participation has been cancelled;
2. When your conference participation has been cancelled, the Humanities International Office may decide how much of your scholarship will be claimed back;
3. In case your conference period has to be cancelled or has been interrupted, the Humanities International Office may decide how much of your scholarship will be claimed back;
4. In case you do not return in time to continue your study at Leiden University, the Humanities International Office may decide how much of your scholarship will be claimed back;
5. In case of fraud or other forms of misconduct, the Humanities International Office may decide how much of your scholarship will be claimed back.

Your scholarship is a single award intended for the sole purpose of funding your conference participation.
