Rules, Regulations and Application Procedure for Eurolife Scholarship

Purpose and nature of the scholarship

In order to promote our Eurolife partners, 3 scholarships of € 500 each are available for our outgoing LUMC students. A LUMC student who would like to go to an Eurolife partner for a research internship can apply for this scholarship. When thinking of applying, it is important that you are a good and very motivated student. More information is available at the Coordinator Internationalisering.

Conditions

- 1. The student must be enrolled at Leiden University during the academic year for which the scholarship is to be awarded, and should have obtained his or her first-year diploma (*propaedeuse*).
- 2. Leiden University recognizes the study or internship abroad as an element of the Leiden study (as a programme component, an optional subject or an extra subject), and awards study credits accordingly.
- 3. The study period or internship should be for a minimum of 4 weeks and a maximum of 12 months.
- 4. After accepting the scholarship, the applicant is required to hand in a scientific report to the scholarship committee at the end of the research project.

Application procedure

- -A description of the research project
- -A motivation for the chosen university
- -A transcript of records
