## 1 Orientation

12-9 months in advance

- You are a second year, motivated student who is interested in doing an Applied Sciences or (Bio)Chemistry related minor at one of our international partner universities during the fifth semester of your Bachelor. You have no study delay and a GPA of at least 7.0. Please note that you need to have obtained at least 90 ECTS by **1 May 2019** to be eligible for an exchange. The ranking of students who apply for exchange is based on academic achievement. Excellent students are also allowed to apply for a non-European/Uni-Wide partner.

## 2 Preparation

9-6 months in advance

- Compose your study programme with your Academic Counsellor.
- The internal selection deadline is **1 February 2019 (EU destinations, Leiden and Delft)**. The application form for all EU-destinations can be found on the **Brightspace course** 'International Office Applied Sciences'. For Leiden University the online application can be found via the website (approval and application). Your application needs to consist of the following supporting documents:
  - Application form Study Abroad;
  - A motivation letter of max. 500 words (1 per destination), in which you are explaining your choice of subjects and showing the coherence of the planned programme – in English and addressed to the partner university;
  - Your latest transcript of records including GPA (available at the Service Desk);
  - An overview of the courses that you would like to follow (a provisional study plan) for each destination;

Please send your application as one .pdf file by email to the International Office TNW and the Science International Office Leiden.

- Once you have been selected, submit the form 'vrije minor' with your programme proposal to the Secretary Board of Examiners LST to apply for approval.
- Apply at the partner university, after you have been nominated by your home institution.
- Apply for funding.
