1 Orientation

9-6 months in advance

- You are a motivated student, who has a GPA of at least 7.0, who is on track without any study delay and finished the first year. Please note you need to have obtained at least 90 ECTS by 1 May 2017 to be eligible for an exchange. You are interested in doing an Applied Sciences or (bio)Chemistry related minor at one of our international partner universities during the fifth semester of your Bachelor.

2 Preparation

6-3 months in advance

- Compose your study programme with your Academic Counsellor.
- The internal selection deadline is **1 February 2017**. Your application needs to consist of the following:
 - Application form Study Abroad;
 - A motivation letter of max. 500 words (1 per destination), in which you are explaining your choice of subjects and showing the coherence of the planned programme – in English and addressed to the partner university;
 - Your latest transcript of records including GPA (available at Service Desk);
 - An overview of the courses that you would like to follow (a provisional study plan) for each destination;Please send your application as one .pdf file by e-mail to the International Office TNW and the International Office FWN.
- After the selection, submit a letter with your programme proposal to the Secretary Board of Examiners to apply for approval from the Board of Examiners MST.
- Apply at the partner university, after you have been nominated by your home university.
- Apply for funds, for more information please visit <http://grantsguide.tudelft.nl>, www.tnw.tudelft.nl/facultyfund and <http://www.students.leiden.edu/your-study/study-abroad/funds>. The International Office TNW and the International Office FWN will provide support with the fund application(s).
